



Important Questions & Answers Youth Should Know

1. What is the emergency contact number for our school/organization?
2. Do you know what to do in the case of a fire or emergency procedure (chemical spill, tornado, etc.)?
3. Do you know where the first aid kit, fire extinguishers, and other emergency equipment are located?
4. Do you know what to do if you get hurt, or if you almost get hurt at work?

Answer: Tell your supervisor immediately. You must report any injury to your supervisor, no matter how trivial the incident/injury may seem.

5. What are your rights as a worker?

Answer: The right to **know**, the right to **participate** & the right to **refuse** unusually dangerous work.

6. What are your responsibilities as a worker?

Answer: To work safely, report unsafe activities and conditions to a supervisor and properly use and wear PPE (personal protective equipment).

7. Who do you ask if you have health and safety questions at work?

Answer: Occupational Health and Safety representative, or Occupational Health and Safety committee member, or Occupational Health and Safety Officer, etc.
