Workplace Violence Checklist

- Do you have a workplace violence policy?
- Have you done a proper workplace violence hazard assessment?
- Have you taken the proper steps to prevent violence?

Have you implemented proper controls:

- Physical / engineering controls
- Administrative controls
- Personal protective equipment

Do you have procedures in place for:


- Reporting violence
- Calling for help and emergency response
- Investigating incidents of violence, and threats of violence

- Do you discipline workers for acts and threats of violence?
- Do you keep written records of workplace violence training?
- Do you monitor the effectiveness of your workplace violence prevention measures?
- Do you provide information, assistance, and/or support to victims of workplace violence?
