



# EMPLOYER & WORKER RESPONSIBILITIES

## Employer Responsibilities:

1. Employers must make sure the workplace is safe.
2. Employers must train managers and supervisors and ensure they're supported and accountable for achieving workplace health and safety requirements.
3. Employers must train you to do your job safely and ensure you are supervised.
4. Employers must work with the Occupational Health and Safety Committee.
5. Employers must keep you safe from harassment.

## Worker Responsibilities:

1. Workers must follow safe work procedures.
2. You must tell your supervisor if you get hurt or if you have almost got hurt (this is called a near miss).
3. Workers must behave and work safely.
4. Workers should tell their supervisor if they see anything that can hurt someone else (this is called an unsafe condition).
5. Worker must ensure a safe workplace by collaborating with their occupational health and safety committee on safety concerns.
