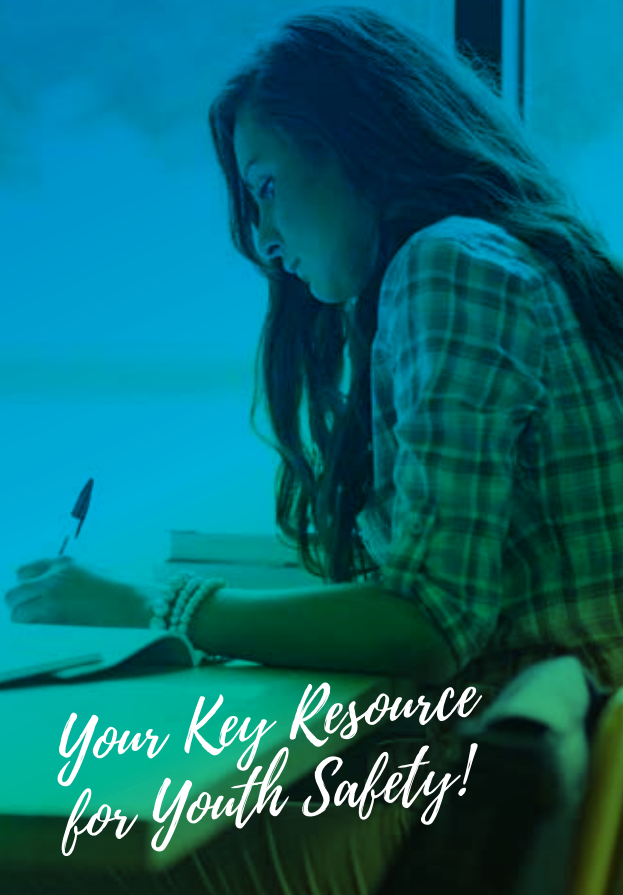

Each year, over 80,000 young workers are employed in Saskatchewan and on average 4,000 young workers are injured. The Regina and Saskatoon hospitality industries account for approximately 800 of these injuries.

Teaching youth the importance of workplace safety at a young age is critical.

Over the last 3 years, we have educated and trained over 110,000 youth in school divisions across the province.

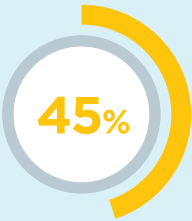
# Know the Facts
